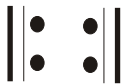

D.C. at CODA ⊕ CODA

4 FOUR BEATS TO THE BAR

4 EACH BEAT IS A 1/4-NOTE LONG (CROCHET)



MUSICAL BRACKETS: PLAY EVERYTHING INSIDE THESE TWICE UNLESS OTHERWISE DIRECTED



REPEAT THE PREVIOUS BAR



CRESCENDO: PROGRESSIVELY INCREASE VOLUME

D.C. Al CODA

“D.C” MEANS “DA CAPO” - “RETURN TO THE HEAD” (BEGINNING). WITH “AL CODA”, THIS MEANS PLAY AS FAR AS THE CODA SYMBOL, THEN CARRY ON FROM WHERE IT SAYS “CODA”
